### The Principal's Post

Thanks to all of you for a smooth start to the 2015-2016 school year. Our students at Jonathan Valley make me very proud to be their principal each and every day for many reasons, not the least of which is their outstanding academic achievement. Last year 69.7% of our students in grades 3-5 were at or above grade level on their EOG tests in reading, math, and science. Out of 857 Title I elementary schools in NC, Jonathan Valley ranks 97th which places us in the top 12% in the state. (A Title I school is defined as one which has at least 40% of their students living in an economically disadvantaged situation and that is measured by the number of students who qualify for free or reduced lunch.) As parents, you helped the students reach those high academic marks by encouraging reading each night, helping with homework, and being your children's biggest cheerleaders and advocates.

We have a lot of really great things going on every day in each classroom. One thing we're doing this year as an entire school is that we have a Word of the Week each week. All of the words are science related. So far we've discussed and had interaction regarding precipitation, humidity, evaporation, and condensation. Ask your child what the word of the week is and see what they say! We have a visiting author who is coming on September 16 to read her book to our students and talk to them about writing and being a published author. The really cool thing is that the author is from Haywood County. Of course in early October we will have fire prevention activities and our fall festival. If you're interested in volunteering at our fall festival, please call for more information.

Thank you for giving me the opportunity to be your child's principal. Although my job includes many and varied activities, the ones I cherish the most are the ones that directly involve interaction with the children. They are why I come to work every day! I try really hard to communicate well and often with parents about what we've got going on at school. If you don't really like the automated phone calls, please be aware that you can sign up for texts and/or emails in addition to the phone calls.
